

The GDPR clause

Fulfilling the information obligation under Article 13(1) and (2) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) [OJ EU L. 2016.119.1 of 4 May 2016], hereinafter referred to as the GDPR, we inform you that:

- The Administrator of your personal data is the AGH University of Krakow, Al. Mickiewicza 30, 30-059 Krakow, hereinafter referred to as AGH;

- Your data will be processed for the purpose of registration for a scientific event, communicating with participants in connection with the organization of the scientific event, documenting its course, and securing data in case of potential claims;
- Your personal data will be processed:
 - a) pursuant to Article 6(1)(e) of the GDPR in connection with the Act of 20 July 2018, the Law on Higher Education and Science (consolidated text: Journal of Laws of 2021, item 478, as amended) and the mission implemented by the University thereunder, which is to conduct scientific activities, disseminate and enhance scientific achievements, participate in social development, as well as shape civic attitudes and create an innovation-based economy;
 - b) pursuant to Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR, i.e., processing is necessary for the conclusion and performance of a contract, the subject of which is participation in a scientific event;
 - c) pursuant to Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR, i.e., processing is necessary for the Administrator to fulfill legal obligations in the scope of financial and accounting documentation and reporting;
- Recipients of your personal data may be:
 - a) entities to which the Administrator is obliged to transfer data under applicable legal provisions;
 - b) entities providing services to the Administrator to the extent necessary for the purposes for which your personal data is processed;
- Your personal data may be transferred to state authorities, law enforcement authorities (Police, Prosecutor's Office, Court) or local government authorities in connection with ongoing proceedings;
- Your personal data will be processed only for the period necessary to achieve the purposes of personal data processing, i.e., for the period of organization and duration of the scientific event, as well as for the period of enforceability of potential claims and for the period resulting from generally applicable legal provisions;

- You have the right to request from the Administrator access to your data and the right to rectify it, the right to delete data, the right to limit data processing, and the right to object to its processing in the cases and under the conditions specified in the GDPR;
- You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority – the President of the Personal Data Protection Office pursuant to Article 77 of the GDPR (...every data subject shall have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority, (...) if the data subject considers that the processing of personal data relating to him or her infringes this Regulation);
- Your personal data will not be subject to automated decision-making, including profiling;
- Providing personal data is voluntary, but necessary for the Administrator to achieve the purposes for which it was collected. The consequence of not providing personal data will be the inability to participate in the scientific event;
- The Administrator reserves the right to take photos and videos during meetings, which may be used for promotional purposes in printed and electronic publications and in social media on the profiles of the Administrator's organizational units. In accordance with Article 81(2)(2) of the Act of 4 February 1994 on Copyright and Related Rights (consolidated text: Journal of Laws of 2021, item 1062, as amended), the dissemination of the image of a person who is only a detail of a whole, such as an assembly, landscape or public event, does not require their permission.
